


Why Do People Go To The Emergency Room?



Accidents happen! A **BROKEN BONE** or **SPRAIN** can be painful and should be looked at right away.

A deep **CUT** may need stitches or a bad **BURN** may need a medicine to help it heal.



Sometimes kids get **SICK**. A high fever, stomachache, or even an earache can need a doctor fast.

If you are sick or hurt and need help right away you go to the Emergency Room. Doctors and nurses are there day and night, ready to help.

What Will Happen in the ER?



The first person you will meet is a **TRIAGE NURSE**. They will take your temperature, heart rate, and blood pressure. They will check how sick your are.


The SICKEST people always go first.




Time to See the Doctor!


