

Why Do Kids Go To the Hospital?


Sometimes kids get SICK.

They may fall and break a bone, burn themselves, or hit their head. Any big injury is usually treated at the hospital.




Some Kids Need Extra Help



HEART and LUNGS




Check your **BLOOD PRESSURE**




Check your **TEMPERATURE**

A Doctor May Need to Run Special Tests


Sometimes a doctor needs to see INSIDE your body. The special tests below can let a doctor see different systems of your body. They don't hurt at all!




MRI Machine - uses magnets to take pictures of tissues and organs inside your body



CT Scanner - uses multiple x-rays to see details of your bones and some organs




X-Ray Machine - takes pictures of your bones

Doctors use all kinds of tools to make you healthy again. Draw a line from the picture to the description of the tools doctors at hospitals use every day.




IV BAG

Gets you to the hospital quickly






Helps your doctor know who you are and why you are there




X-RAY

Takes a picture of your bones




ANESTHESIA MASK
