Developed by a scientist, DOM/DOB were compounds produced in the 1960's to create a less potent LSD. However, because users increase the recommended dosage, the effects can be more potent than LSD.

Severe reactions at a festival, when the crowd got out of hand, drew attention to DOM and within a year, DOM, or STP- Serenity, Tranquility, and Peace, was on a banned list in the U.S.

DOB is a variation of DOM and has been known to have affects for days after use. Many users believe they are taking LSD when using DOB, and find out the hard way that DOB has more serious side effects, including amputation and death.

DRUG_I.D.

Looks: Powder or pill form- resembles amphetamines

Street Names: STP, The Love Drug

Methods of Use: Oral ingestion or nasal inhalation

Actions: Stimulant and psuedo-hallucinogenic, lasting 8-24 hours

Warning Signs: Hallucinations, mood swings, and increased heart rate

TRAGEDIES

Some users report having side effects of panic attacks days after use. STP-induced psychosis has been reported to last for years after use. Vascular damage from DOB has led to brain damage, amputations, coma, and death.



EFFECTS_OF_USE

- Blurred vision
- Visual hallucinations
- Increased blood pressure
- Sense of slowing time
- Visual distortion
- Amputations
- Death

WAY_TO_GO

Originally designed as a form of LSD that wouldn't last long, it had the opposite effect because dealers upped the dosage. These LSD alternatives are a Schedule I drug in the U.S., which means it is illegal to manufacturer, possess, or sell these substances.
