

Law enforcement officers are men and women. They are community helpers just like teachers, doctors and firefighters.




Law enforcement officers' special job is to make sure that everyone obeys the law.

(Color in the areas marked P, A, R, T, N, E, and R to reveal the image.)




You can identify a law enforcement officer by his or her uniform. It might be blue, black, tan or green.

(Color in each of the 4 officers below with one of the above colors.)




A person in uniform is only a law enforcement officer if they are wearing a proper badge. (Connect the dots to reveal the shapes of the different badges.)




Law enforcement officers wear special work belts to carry all of their important tools.

Some drive patrol cars.




Some law enforcement officers fly helicopters.




Some officers ride bicycles.
