TRAGEDIES

Calls to Poison Control Centers, as a result of contact with Synthetic Marijuana, doubled from 2010 to 2011, to almost 7,000 calls.

11.4% of 12th graders admit to using synthetic marijuana, making it the 2nd most abused drug by high school seniors.
