WHAT ARE MUSHROOM

Mushroom edibles are gummies and chocolates that claim to be psychoactive—without containing illegal psilocybin. Marketed as a legal way to get high, these products are showing up in gas stations, smoke shops, and online.

The most common mushroom used in these products is nicknamed the "Mario mushroom" because it looks like th red-and-white spotted mushroom from the Mario Brothers video game.

Some products claim to be psychoactive while also claiming to contain only non-psychoactive mushrooms—an obvious contradiction.





Testing by researchers and federal regulators has shown that these products may contain a wide range of unlisted—and potentially dangerous or illegal—ingredients:

- Psilosybin-the psychoactive compound found in "magic" mushrooms
- Psilocia A related psychedelic substance similar to psilocybin an herb that produces opioid-like
- effects

WHAT IS THE RISK?

Testing has shown the edibles contain dangerous chemicals that have caused a variety of symptoms, including:



Respiratory failure





Loss of consciousness






Changes in blood pressure



Nausea and vomitina



Even if mushroom edibles only contain the "Mario mushroom," their legal status is still unclear.

While the mushroom itself is legal in many states, laws don't clearly address commercial production or sale. This legal gray area allows brands to avoid oversight or skirt regulation altogether
