
Police officers are friends who help keep our cities and towns safe. Police officers help with emergencies, solve crimes, and protect people.



If you are ever in trouble, a police officer can help!




CROSSING THE STREET

Police officers want you to always remember to lock your bike when you leave it, even if you are only going to be away for a minute.


IF YOU GET LOST ...

Most police officers walk or drive a patrol car. There are many ways that police officers patrol the streets. Can you circle all of the different ways that police officers travel around your town?




POLICE DOGS

Stay safe around police dogs! Never approach a police dog without first asking permission from their handler.


CALLING 9-1-1



It is important to know how to call for help in an emergency. If someone is sick, hurt, or in danger, pick up the phone and call 9-1-1.


The police will come to help you.

GUN SAFETY




If you see a gun - **NEVER PICK IT UP!** Leave it alone. Turn around and tell an adult or call the police.

DRUG REFUSAL




Police officers want you to know that drugs are bad for you. If you see anyone, even other kids, taking drugs, smoking, or drinking alcohol, walk away!
