

SMILES

Smiles, technically known as 2C-I, is a synthetic drug which has been linked to deaths and self-inflicted wounds by its users.

Smiles is a Schedule I drug, which means it is illegal under all circumstances, because it comes with such a high risk of overdose and death.

DRUG_I.D.

Looks: Usually a white powder substance, sold in capsules or packets, or dissolved into liquid. Liquid is usually placed on a blotter paper.

Street Names: Smiles

Methods of Use: Can be ingested or inhaled. Liquid blotter paper is dissolved in mouth.

Actions: Unpredictable mental effects; leaves user out of touch with reality for 4-12 hours

Warning Signs: Aggression, organ failure, extreme hallucinations, seizures

TRAGEDIES

In 2012 an 18 year old was charged with manslaughter after supplying the drug to his friend.

A supply of Smiles killed 1 and sent 2 others to the hospital during a New Orleans music festival in 2012.
