Synthetic cocaine is a chemical alteration of cocaine, which can be different from package to package. Physical effects can be severe and unpredictable. In this regard, it can be more dangerous than real cocaine.

Many of these drugs can be found online, in convenience stores, and head shops. They are usually marketed with the warning label "Not intended for human consumption."

Looks: Usually a fine white or off white powder; packaged in 200 or 500 mg plastic or foil pouches

Street Names: Blue Silk, Cloud Nine, Drone, Energy-1, Ivory Wave, Lunar Wave, Meow Meow, Ocean Burst, Pure Ivory, Purple Wave, Red Dove, Snow Leopard, Stardust, Vanilla Sky, White Dove, White Knight, White Lightening

Methods of Use: Usually sniffed or snorted. Can be taken orally, smoked or put into a solution to inject in the veins.

Actions: An addictive stimulant which gives high energy to begin with, but users become agitated and experience hallucinations.

Warning Signs: Chest pain, nosebleeds, seizures, panic attacks, vomiting
