WHAT ONSEN

Consent is when two people both agree to have sex. Any sexual activity without consent is rape or sexual assault. There are many conditions to this rule, though, and breaking any of them makes the sex non-consensual.

onsent requires that everyone be the right state of mind, capable decision making and evaluating e full situation

If you are under 18 If you are drunk If you are high U CAN NOT CONSENT!

NO ALWAYS **MEANS NO**

When someone says "no," they mean it. It doesn't mean that she or he is playing hard to get. Just as consent is invalid without a verbal and enthusiastic "yes," a "no" is an immediate and clear rejection that must be respected. Always respect "no." If they are not interested, stop immediately. Even if they say no and ask to stop during sex, it must be respected. To continue after a clear rejection is sexual harassment, and, if taken further, sexual assume sexual assault

CONSEQUENCES FOR THE OFFENDER

- Years in prison for sexual assault
